Compliance Requirements:

- Timelines: The Risk Assessment is required to be completed:
 - MH: Within a clinically appropriate timeframe from discharge from acute care 24 hour facilities (hospital or crisis house) and thereafter anytime a client presents with risk factors. The County of San Diego is defining a "clinically appropriate timeframe" as between 72 hours and 5 days post discharge.
 - Please note that if the risk assessment cannot be completed for any reason within timeframes the documentation must at minimum document attempted efforts to complete the risk assessment and/or reasons why it was not completed on time.
 - o SUD:
- Outpatient programs To be reviewed and signed by LPHA within 7 calendar days from day of admit.
- Residential programs To be reviewed and signed by LPHA within 24 hours from day of admit.
- If risk is indicated, the development of a plan to manage safety is required. See "Safety Plan Explanation Sheet" for instructions. Programs may utilize their own template for safety plans but must use the Risk Assessment in SmartCare.
- Suicidality/Other Risk to Self If selected, then Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale

^{*}The following may compete under the direct supervision of a Behavioral Health Professional*

(CSSRS) must be completed. See the CSSRS Adult and Child form fills help text for instructions.

- Scope of Practice:
 - o MH: If completed by an unlicensed staff, a consultation with a licensed staff needs to take place and the assessment must be co-signed.
 - o SUD: if completed by an SUD Counselor, the assessment must be reviewed and signed by an LPHA.

Documentation Standards:

- Use help text prompts to complete ALL form fill sections.
 - O Select all check boxes that apply in each section.
- Suicidality/Other Risk to Self If selected, then Columbia Suicide Severity Rating Scale (CSSRS) must be completed. See the CSSRS Adult and Child form fills help text for instructions.
- When you search for *Risk Assessment* in Smartcare, you will see two options: Risk Assessment and Risk Assessment (c). The correct Risk Assessment to utilize is the one that says "Risk Assessment" without the (c).
- If downtime form is utilized, it must be scanned/uploaded into SmartCare Electronic Health Record (EHR).
